# Mr. Chiqui Esteban

Beyond words: how graphics have become a success story in journalism

Mr. Chiqui Esteban started working for *The Washington Post* in March 2016 and became the Graphics Director in January 2018.

Before joining *The Washington Post*, he worked as Deputy Director of Art, Graphics and Maps at *National Geographic* and Graphics Director at *The Boston Globe*.

Mr. Esteban's honors and awards include multiple international news design awards, including the Society for News Design, the European Newspapers Award, the Online Journalism Award, as well as many others. He received the prestigious Malofiej Award for Infographics, for accomplishments in journalistic infographics.

Mr. Esteban received his bachelor's degree in journalism from the Universidad de Navarra in Spain.
