## The Room Change Request process is active now

After the start of each semester, our office opens the process for students who would like to request a room change. While we are limited in available spaces this semester, we wanted to offer students the opportunity to put in a submission to change rooms.

Based on the current number of available spaces, we cannot guarantee approvals for all submitted requests. The Office of Residential Life will review all submissions and notify residents of the decision regarding their request after the submission deadline has passed.

Please Note:

- All requests must be submitted by the deadline of Thursday, Feb. 2 to be considered.
- Only 1 request can be made per student. Person for person swaps must be mutual.
- All final decisions are overseen by the Office of Residential Life.
- Submitted information that is inaccurate will void the request.
- All approved moves must be completed by Monday, Feb. 13 by 10 p.m. Moving into spaces without pre-approval can result in judicial follow up.
- Failure to comply with directions or deadlines can result in additional financial charges.

## SAFETY REMINDERS

As the new semester kicks off, it is important to remember the policies in place to keep our residential communities safe.

- Smoking of any kind is prohibited in the residence halls which includes student rooms, bathrooms, and other common areas. Tobacco use is prohibited on campus except in designated areas. Cannabis use and/or possession is prohibited on campus, as required by federal law under the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act.
- Firearms, knives, and other weapons are prohibited on campus and in the residence halls. This includes recreational weapons, such as airsoft guns, paintball guns, and gel blaster guns.
- Please do not prop exterior doors to the residence halls. This puts building security at risk and creates an entryway for pests and vermin.
  Students will be sanctioned under the Code of Conduct if found responsible for propping doors or otherwise tampering with door locks.
- Smoke detectors may not be covered or otherwise tampered with. Tampering with fire safety equipment is a violation of the Code of Conduct and endangers the lives of all community members.

Please help us maintain the safety of our residence halls by following these policies and communicating with our staff when safety concerns arise.
