

- 3. Click on "Banner SSB" and login using your credentials
- 4. Under your Student Profile, login using your credentials
- 5. In the corner of the page, registration and hold information EX:
 - To clear the hold you must work with the department or individual who initiated the hold.

 For example, if you have an outstanding bill, the Bursar may place a hold on your account.
