The Summer Science Program offered by the ICaRE (Institute of Cancer Research and Education) at SUNY Old Westbury provides High School students with an exciting opportunity to engage in a research project focused on cancer biology. Participants will gain handson experience with a variety of scientific techniques commonly used in fields such as molecular biology of cancer, cell biology, cancer immunology, biochemistry, neuroscience and microbiology under the mentorship of Faculty. Students will learn how laboratory science can be translated to improved human health and will engage in investigative experiences. Our program gives students the opportunity to:

- 1. Understand the process of the scientific method
- 2. Apply knowledge to a real world problem and gain research skills.
- 3. Learn key laboratory methodologies.
- 4. Learn critical reading of peer-reviewed literature on an unknown topic.
- 5. Gain experience presenting scientific work through writing and oral presentation
- 6. Have fun learning about the science!

PROGRAM TIMELINE

- April 15: Application deadline
- May 1: Notification of acceptance

PROGRAM DETAIL

- The tuition for a one-week session is \$950, and is **nonrefundable** (\$50 discount if paid by May 15th)
- Two-week applications are prioritized over one-week if the program is full.
