What Information and Documents Do I Need to Complete the FAFSA?

Here is a checklist of the information and documents you should have with you as you complete the 2015-2016 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

-  Student's social security number. Have the card to ensure the number is correct.
-  Parents' social security number.
-  Parents' dates of birth.
-  Student's driver's license number, if you have one.
-  Student's Permanent Alien Registration Number, if student is not a U.S. citizen.
-  Copy of student's 2015 Federal Income Tax Return.
 - If not yet filed, then last pay stubs for each job held during 2015 and copy of student's 2014 Federal Income Tax Return
-  Copy of parents' 2015 Federal Income Tax Return.
 - If not yet filed, use each parents' last pay stub for every job held in 2015 and copy of parents' 2014 Federal Income Tax Return
-  Records of student's 2015 untaxed income from the following sources of income:

- Child support payments received in the student's name
- Interest income
- Veterans non-education benefits
- Social security benefits in the student's name



Records of parents' 2015 untaxed income from the following sources of income:

- Child support payments received in the student's name
- Interest income
- Veterans non-education benefits
- Untaxed portion of pension benefits
- Untaxed portion of IRA deductions
- Untaxed portion of IRA distributions
- Workers' compensation benefits
- Disability benefits
- Social security benefits
