**Application Packet
2017-18 Scholarship Program**

This \$1,000 scholarship is designed to support students of SUNY Old Westbury in recognition of either their own service or the service of a loved one in a branch of the United States Military. This scholarship is made available through a series of generous gifts made in memory of Mr. Calvin O. Butts, II, who was himself a veteran, after his passing in April 2014.

Students applying for this award must meet the following criteria and complete the following information:

- Scholarships for serving members of any branch of the armed forces of the United States of America, including national guard or reserve units, any honorably discharged veteran of such service, and any spouse or child of any such person, with priority given to any applicant that is an actively serving member.
- Must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (based on a 4 point system) at the time of applying, and be in good judicial standing.
- Submission of a resume showing evidence of military service (or connection to military service), strong community and campus involvement.
- One (1) letter of recommendation from a member of the community, military, or College faculty or staff.
- Full-time or Part-time students may apply.
- An essay (two pages maximum) that conveys how being engaged in a life that includes military service has impacted the applicant with an emphasis on leadership, scholarship, service and brotherhood/sisterhood.

Application Due: Friday, August 4, 2017.

Applications must be post-marked or dropped off by the end of the business day. Incomplete and late applications will not be accepted. You may drop off your applications and the related required material to the Office of Institutional Advancement, room H-425, Campus Center or mail to:

General Requirements for All Scholarships Of
the Old Westbury College Foundation, Inc.

- A. Scholarship awards may only be used toward the college costs at SUNY Old Westbury and are posted to the awardees account with the Office of the Bursar, unless otherwise specified.
- B. The award will be disbursed in two equal amounts. The first half will be issued during the fall semester and the remaining half in the spring semester. **Recipients will receive the spring semester's award only if he/she continues to fulfill the scholarship requirements.**
- C. If the recipient is a graduating senior, the final semester's award will not exceed the cost of tuition and fees.
- D. If a student is awarded more than one scholarship award, the total amount of all the awards may not exceed the student's tuition and fees.
