Application Packet 2017-18 Scholarship Program

\$1,000 scholarships will be made available through the generous support of sponsors and attendees at the State University of New York at Old Westbury's annual Panther Pride Homecoming Celebration. At least one scholarship each will be awarded to a student (if eligible) enrolled in each of the College's academic school.

Students applying for this award must meet the following criteria and/or complete the following information:

- Open to students who will be matriculated as sophomores, juniors, or seniors at SUNY Old Westbury during the 2017-18 academic year.
- Full-time or part-time students may apply.
- Must possess 3.0 grade point average (based on a 4 point system). A 3.0 grade point average must be maintained during the 2017-18 academic year for the award to be posted to the account(s) of the awardee(s).
- A written statement highlighting his or her exceptional community service and that outlines the significant leadership role taken on by the applicant in one or more student organizations or college committees (service on the Panther Pride Week committee preferred). The applicant's submission is an essential factor in selecting scholarship recipients. The Committee will judge submissions for composition, conveying thoughts accurately and precisely, grammar and spelling.
- Though financial need is not a requirement, students should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with the Office of Financial Aid
