Application Packet 2017-18 Scholarship Program

This \$1,000 scholarship is made available through a generous gift by The Robert Plan Corporation to the Old Westbury College Foundation, Inc. Students applying for this award must meet the following criteria and/or complete the following information:

- Open to currently enrolled and new incoming transfer students who will be matriculated at SUNY College at Old Westbury during the 2017-18 academic year.
- Full-time or Part-time students may apply.
- Must major in one of the degree programs in the School of Business.
- Must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (based on a 4 point system) at the time of applying, and must maintain that GPA throughout the 2017-18 academic year.
- Must be a United States citizen and a New York State resident.
- Two faculty recommendations on official letterhead.
- An original essay, 500 words minimum, entitled, *The Influence of Cultural and Minority Communities in the Modern Business Environment*.

The applicant's essay/submission is an essential factor in selecting scholarship recipients. The Committee will judge essays/submissions on both theme and composition (development of ideas with appropriate detail and examples, overall organization, paragraphing, etc.).

Application Due: Friday, August 4, 2017.

Applications must be post-marked or dropped off by the end of the business day. Incomplete and late applications will not be accepted. You may drop off your applications and the related required material to the Office of Institutional Advancement, room H-425 Campus Center or mail to:
