➤ What is Residence Hall Association (RHA)?

- RHA is an org committed to creating an enjoyable residential experience and developing an environment that is welcoming to all that reside in the Halls by providing exciting and educational events, being advocates, and developing/ implementing reshall policies. RHA works as the residential student government and oversees the RHCs. All students living in the halls have the opportunity to participate in the General Board or if elected in the Executive Board. RHA's plan to create a space for residents to make us aware of residence hall concerns, to improve the overall community.

➤ Residence Hall Councils (RHC)

- Residence Hall Council (RHC) is an organization that is open to all students that reside in the Woodlands Residence Halls and operates under the RHA. Each residence hall will have its own RHC that meets weekly to address residency issues, plan events, participate in community service initiatives, and coordinate other activities. All students living in the halls have the opportunity to participate in their hall's Residence Hall Council in the General Board or if elected in the Executive Board. RHC's plan to create a space for residents to make RHA aware of residence hall concerns, to improve the overall community.

- President
 - Presides over RHA Meetings & Conference Rep
 - Works with RHC E-boards to uphold positions
- Vice President
 - Recognition & Recruitment Chair
 - Maintains all RHC Programming Paperwork
- Secretary
 - Manages RHA Email & records meeting notes
- Treasurer
 - Tracks RHA & RHC Funds & Reports funding
- Public Relations Officer
 - Promotion for events & runs social media
- National Communication Coordinator (NCC)
 - Works with RHA & NRHH for Conferences
- Campus Communications Coordinator (CCC)
 - Liaison for RHA, attends SGA Senate Meetings

RHC Executive Board Positions

- President
 - Presides over all RHA Meetings
 - Works with RHC E-boards to uphold positions
- Vice President
 - Recognition & Recruitment Chair
 - Works with President to plan meetings
- Secretary
 - Records meeting notes & attendance
- Treasurer
 - Tracks RHC funds
- Public Relations Officer
- RHA Representatives
 - Attends weekly RHA Meetings as a RHC Rep
- Wing Representatives
 - Acts as a voice to report residents needs
