- If you choose an oral presentation, you will be asked to indicate your session availability. You will be expected to remain for the entire session and arrive 5 minutes before your scheduled session.
- Based on your availability, you will be assigned a 15-minute time slot (includes Q&A).
- If you will be displaying slides, please bring a USB thumb drive with the file.

### **POSTER or ART/MEDIA PRESENTATIONS:**

- If you choose to participate by presenting a poster or art/media exhibit, this session is scheduled for Common Hour 2:30pm – 3:40pm.
- You are expected to stand by your poster or exhibit during the entire session. You may choose to display your poster or exhibit before and/or after the session as well.
- Posters should be 36" x 48". We suggest creating your poster in Microsoft PowerPoint. **Posters completed by April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 can be printed by the college.**
