Fall 2019 Housing Checklist:

• You must be a full-time status student (12 Credits or more)
• You are eligible for campus housing only if you are in good academic standing - 2.0 Cumulative GPA or above by Fall semester
• You must be financially clear with the Bursar Office
• You must be in good judicial standing.

Make the Grade!



- You are eligible for campus housing only if you are in good academic standing - **2.0 Cumulative OW GPA or above**
- If you are concerned about a course, then discuss it with the faculty and the earlier the better.
- **Please note: Exceptions ARE NOT** automatically approved if you fall under a 2.0 cumulative OW GPA to stay in housing. Students looking for assistance must go through the First Year Office (for freshmen in their first semester at OW) and Academic Advising (for transfers in their first semester at OW).

If you feel as though you are struggling academically, you should know you are not alone. In fact, we have a host of services (listed on the last page) for students that provide exactly this type of support and they are free to use; so take advantage!

Spring 2020 Bill Payment:

You must be financially clear with the Office of the Bursar

The following methods are available for payment:

- Credit Card: Old Westbury accepts VISA, MasterCard and Discover credit card payments which are processed online using the web credit card payment option available on your E-Bill which can be accessed via **ConnectOW**.
- Check: Check payments can be made on-line via the **ConnectOW portal**.
- Scholarship Check: Place scholarship checks in separate sealed envelope with appropriate documentation and forward to the Office of Bursar at the address below. Include the student's identification number ("700" number) with all submissions.
