# RESLIFES PACKING GUIDE

### Encouraged Items:

- Bedding/Bath: Extra long sheet set (twin)
- Mattress/Memory foam pad
  - Comforter/Pillows
  - Bath towels/Bathrobe
  - Seasonal clothes, hangers

Cleanliness:
Laundry Supplies (Detergent, Hamper, etc.)
Shower Supplies including flip flops/sandles
Toiletries (Deodorant, Toothbrush, Shaving Supplies, etc.)
Cleaning Supplies (Paper towels, Deodorizing spray, Dish soap, etc.)

## **Electronic Devices**:

- Approved room lamps (no more than 2 heads)
- Surge Protectors (must have an on/off switch)
  - Ethernet Cords
  - TV, DVD, Gaming Systems
    - Laptop

### - Umbrella - Prescription Medication - Health Insurance Card(s) - First aid kit - Flashlight/Batteries/Lightbulbs

#### **REMINDERS**:

You will be sharing a room, so bring your essentials and try not to over pack. (University furniture cannot be stored or removed from building.) You may want to contact your roommate in advance to talk about shared items (Refridgerator, TV, etc). Refridgerators cannot exceed 115-120 volts, 2.0 running amps, 5 cubic feet, and must be UL approved. You are also able to rent a microfridge (info on website). **We encourage you to bring hand carts to assist with your move**. The campus shuttle makes regular stops into town incase you forget any items. Stores include Dollar Tree, Target, and the North Broadway Mall

### Prohibited Items:

Fire arms or other weapons (or reasonable facsimiles thereof)
 Knives (outside of those for the sole purpose of cooking) and/or switchblades

- Alcohol beverages/liquors

- Alcohol bottles, cans, and containers used for decorative or any other purpose
  - Alcohol paraphernalia including but not limited to: Kegs, Beer Ball, taps, shot glasses, beer pong tables, funnels, etc
    - Illegal drugs & prescription medications not in your name
      - Drug paraphernalia hookahs, grinders, etc
- Candles, incense, wax melters, or anything that can have an open flame, even if not in use

 Halogen bulbs/lights, medusa lamps, lava lamps, oil and gas lamps, and any lamps with more than 2 heads/bulbs
 Cooking appliances or other high-wattage equipment, such as hot plates/pots, electric coffee pots, immersion heaters, popcorn poppers, electric heaters, electric grying pans, deep fat fryers, electric woks, microwave oves, stoves, toaster ovens, refridgerators over 4.2 cubic feet or any other appliance more

than 1,000 watts, with the exception of hand held hair dryers

- Air conditioners, electric heaters, and heated blankets
- Non-surge protected extension cords or octopuses, or extension splitters
  - Futons, waterbeds, or any mattress not approved by ResLife
- Bed risers/cinder blocks or any other materials used to elevated the bed posts
  - Hoverboards
  - Any product which has been recalled for safety reasons
    - Non-battery powered string lights or rope lights
