### **ORAL PRESENTATIONS**

- Oral presentations are highly encouraged. Oral Presenters will have access to a podium, microphone and projector for a 15-minute formal presentation to an audience that will be followed by a 5 minute Q&A session. The presentation should be developed for a general audience and not a single discipline.
- If you choose an oral presentation, please indicate your session availability. You will be expected to remain for the entire session you choose and arrive at least 5 minutes before your scheduled session.
- If you will be displaying slides, please bring a USB thumb drive with the file.

## **ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSIONS**

- Roundtable discussion will consist of a group of 6-8 students and 2 student moderators in a table/chair setting with a surrounding audience.
- Participants will prepare a 5-minute presentation (no display available, handouts are recommended) and be prepared to engage in a group discussion with the faculty, participants and audience.
- If you choose a roundtable discussion, please indicate your session availability. You will be expected to remain for the entire session you choose and arrive at least 5 minutes before your scheduled session.

## **POSTER/ART/MEDIA PRESENTATIONS**

- If you choose to participate by presenting a poster or art/media exhibit, there will be only one session scheduled for Common Hour 2:30 – 3:40 pm.
- You are expected to stand by your poster or art/media during the entire Common Hour. You may choose to display your poster or art/media exhibit before and/or after the session as well.
- Posters should be 36" x 48". If you choose to present a poster session, we will send via email a template for you to follow (MS PowerPoint format). Posters completed by March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 can be printed by the college at no cost to the faculty or faculty sponsor.
