### **ORAL PRESENTATIONS**

- Oral presentations are highly encouraged. Oral Presenters will have access to a podium, microphone and projector for a 15 minute formal presentation to an audience that will be followed by a 5 minute Q&A session. The presentation should be developed for a general audience rather than a single discipline.
- If you choose an oral presentation, please indicate your session availability. You will be expected to arrive at least 5 minutes before your session time and remain for the entire session you choose.
- If you will be displaying presentation slides, please bring a USB thumb drive with the file to upload before your session.

## **POSTER/ART/MEDIA PRESENTATIONS**

- If you choose to participate by presenting a poster or art/media exhibit, there will be only one session scheduled for Common Hour 2:30 pm – 3:40 pm.
- You are expected to stand by your poster or art/media during the entire Common Hour Session. The posters will be collected before Research Day as they are displayed the morning of the event. Art displays will be coordinated by the Visual Arts Department. (Details will follow.) You may choose to display your art/poster after the session as well.
- Posters should be 36" x 48". If you choose to present a poster session, we will send via email a template for you to follow (MS PowerPoint format). Posters completed by March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 can be printed by the college.
