Below you will find information on how to receive your Sophomore Jump Certificate:

1. Submit a completed Degree Plan to an Academic Advisor in the Academic Advising Center- NAB 1118-A. Choose between two options:
 - a. Attend the Degree Planning Workshop- Nov.6th, NAB 3104, Common hour. Complete and submit your degree plan to NAB 1118-A.
 - b. OR schedule an individual degree planning session with an Academic Advisor in the Academic Advising Center- NAB 1118-A.
2. Attend 2 different workshops/events throughout the academic year. Choose from the following options*:
 - a. Degree Planning Workshop- Nov.6th, NAB 3104, Common hour.
 - b. Get the Rec'- (spring only).
 - c. National Scholarship and Fellowship Info-session- Sept. 18th, NAB 1117, Common hour.
