

Description of Upcoming Alumni Case Studies

In Fall 2018, the School of Education will be launching its first case studies of recent graduates to evaluate both the impact that our graduates have on their students' learning and the in-class performance of the graduates themselves:

1. As many graduates from the previous two years from across as many programs as possible will be included in the case studies.
2. For the part evaluating impact on student learning, the graduates will perform a pre-posttest study on students' comprehension and performance on a course element agreed on by the School of Education and each graduate. The data from each study will be recorded by each graduate and sent to the School of Education. The School of Education, without using any identifying data, will present the data for each pre-posttest case study.
3. For the part evaluating alumni in-class performance, the School of Education and several P-12 partners are developing a rubric to evaluate in-class performance. As many alumni of recent classes will be recruited to participate. Their supervisors will use the rubric while observing them and send the assessment to the School of Education. The School of Education will then aggregate the data, without any identifying data, and publish on its website.
