

SUNY Old Westbury School of Education One-Year Retention Rate

Data presented represents the one-year retention rate of cohorts of student who entered the School of Education (SOE) by semester, dating back to Fall 2013.

For comparison, the last data available for one-year retention at SUNY Old Westbury as a whole is **81% (2014)**.

Undergrad adolescent programs and graduate programs remain aggregated so as to protect student privacy.
