All fingerprinting must go through the approved Statewide Vendor Managed System. The approved vendor for this process is a company called Morpho Trust. For more information about the fingerprint process you can go to the following website: https://www.identogo.com/. To schedule an appointment you can visit their website or call (877) 472-6915. In order to have your fingerprints taken and processed correctly, you need to provide an ORI Number. The ORI Number for NYSED is <u>TEACH</u> and the purpose of fingerprinting is <u>Certification</u>. Under the new process with Morpho Trust, you will create an application and schedule your appointment all through either the website or phone. Price is subject to change.
